

BIO-SKETCH – REV. DR. PETER TIMOTHY



The Rev. Dr. Peter Timothy is an Ordained Deacon of the Catholic Church and has been the Episcopal Delegate for Evangelization for the past six years, a position he vacated in March of this year. Immediately following this, in April, he was appointed Ministry Coordinator for St. Anthony's and St. John's Cluster.

An Assistant Lecturer in the Department of History at the University of the West Indies, St. Augustine Campus, Dr. Timothy is an expert in the study of the History of Caribbean Migration in the twentieth century and has published several history articles in this field including Activities of Trinidad and Tobago Nationals in the United Kingdom and The Republic of Ireland.

Having begun his ministry in 1982 when he took responsibility to form a Youth Prayer Group in the parish of St. John, Dr. Timothy has been in service of the Archdiocese for four decades - years he has described as both wonderful and challenging. He credits the Catholic Charismatic Renewal – particularly St. John's Prayer Group and the Zion Community for his early formation in the Ministry of Intercession.

More recently Dr. Timothy has been a Lecturer in Church History at the Regional Seminary, Lecturer in the Bible at the Catholic Charismatic Renewal Bible Institute, and Lecturer in Intercession and Biblical Figures of Prayer at the Gethsemane Institute of Christian Prayer.

Dr. Timothy has been married to his wife Subina for 34 years and is the father of six children.
